WOLF-Garten makes the cut

Secateurs tested by Stiftung Warentest

At a price of 18 euros, the most inexpensive “good” single-hand secateurs are the WOLF-Garten RR 22 and WOLF-Garten RS 22. This has been determined by the German consumer magazine Stiftung Warentest. In addition, the Wolf RS 830, available for 57 euros, cuts thicker twigs best. Tests were made of 17 single-hand secateurs and 11 branch pruners.

A series of tests carried out with 28 secateurs showed that cheap secateurs break quickly and cannot keep up with brand name products, according to Stiftung Warentest. On the other hand, “good” does not necessarily mean expensive. Two products from WOLF-Garten, which achieved the “good” result of 1.9, are available for 18 euros.

The “best with two cutting edges” (Graded 1.9) is the RR 22. The testers from Berlin certified them as having particularly good cutting qualities with very low, and later low, levels of required force. They are solid, durable and very manageable when cutting.

The RS22 anvil secateurs shone for their good cutting characteristics and initially only require minimal, and later very little, effort when cutting. They are solid and durable and also very handy, according to the Stiftung Warentest.
